BACKGROUND

Our large family-style house in the Southern Suburbs, established nearly fifty years ago as a sanctuary, provides refuge for up to twenty-eight women and their children. Originally founded to assist single, young, pregnant women, our home now offers a safe haven not only to single mothers-to-be who are considering placing baby for adoption, but also to women who are victims of rape, physical and emotional abuse and domestic violence.

We aim to empower the women in our care through skills training and support them by means of a full-time crèche for their children. We help them to find employment and see that they receive legal assistance and medical care.

With the ongoing support of the community we will continue to ensure that our home remains a place of safety, where all who enter will feel cared for and accepted.
